If you fail to comply with these requirements, you will be deemed to have failed to cooperate under 49 CFR, Section 26.109(c) which will initiate the decertification process of your firm as a DBE.

Your firm will be listed in this Department's TUCP DBE Directory. The website address is "<http://www.txdot.gov>". It is your responsibility to ensure that the information in the directory is correct.

If your firm obtains a Federally-assisted contract with agencies in the Texas Unified Certification Program, your firm must perform a Commercially Useful Function (CUF) on the contract. A firm performs a CUF when it is responsible for the execution of the work of the contract and is carrying out its responsibilities by actually performing, managing and supervising the work involved. A firm is also responsible for negotiating price, determining quality and quantity, ordering, paying for and installing (where applicable) the materials and supplies needed to accomplish the contract.
